



IPAC Education Modules

Hand Hygiene & Enhanced Screening:

The Hand Hygiene & Enhanced Screening learning module has been created with the intent to review foundational knowledge for health care workers. This module will help participants identify when/why to perform hand hygiene, explore the principles of handwashing and hand sanitizing, and will review the barriers that impact effective hand hygiene. This module will also highlight enhanced screening methods during COVID-19 including active and passive screening and allow participants to develop a client surveillance process and identify an appropriate strategy for the management of a positive screening.

Cleaning and Disinfecting of Physical Environments:

The Cleaning and Disinfecting of Physical Environments learning module has been created with the intent to review foundational knowledge for health care workers. This module will allow participants to define the key principles and terminology related to cleaning and disinfecting, identify enhanced cleaning and disinfecting of physical environments with relation to COVID-19 and develop an understanding of recommendations to prevent an outbreak of COVID-19. This module will also highlight how to perform cleaning and disinfection of physical environments and explore the difference between high and low touch areas.

Isolation Precaution and Outbreak Management:

The Isolation Precaution and Outbreak Management learning module has been created with the intent to review foundational knowledge for health care workers. This module will allow participants to explain the difference between routine and additional (isolation) precautions and learn point-of-care risk assessment. This module will also highlight the steps of correct donning and doffing of personal protective equipment (PPE) and allow participants to learn how to don and doff gloves, gown, facemask, eye protection and N95 respirator.

IPAC Practice Champion:

The IPAC Practice Champion learning module has been created with the intent to inform, support and develop an IPAC Practice Champion. An IPAC Practice Champion is an individual your organization will select to take a leadership role in developing, implementing and ensuring IPAC best practices in the workplace. We recommend that this individual is someone who is approachable and can provide ongoing education (i.e., occupational health and safety representative).
